Have you ever prayed for "God's will" in your life? What was it you were seeking?

When we come to a crossroads, is there a wrong choice? What will happen if we "miss the dot"?

Read the following verses. How do each of these promises from God ease the burden of making big decisions?

- Deuteronomy 31:6
- Proverbs 16:3
- Romans 8:28

Describe a time when you had to make a life choice.

- Hindsight truly is 20/20. Knowing what you know now, did you make the right choice?
- Whether it was "right" or "wrong," God promises to use all things for good. How did you see God working as a result of that decision?

God does not hide His will from us. He tells us in His word that ultimately His will is the renewing of our mind and our sanctification. **Sanctification** means the process of being made holy, or in essence being made to look more like Jesus.

- In the decision you discussed earlier, how did God use that circumstance to make you look more like Jesus? In what ways have you grown because of that decision?

What does it practically look like to use the filter of sanctification for making decisions?

Share with the group an area of your life you are currently seeking God's will.

Make sure and pray as a group for His wisdom in making these decisions, and that we would all see the ways He is renewing our minds daily.
