Small Group Discussion Guide

- 1. Have you ever had a "How did we get here?" moment—a time when you reflected on how far your life (or aspect of life) has come?
- 2. What are some methods that typically come to mind when you think of church growth and sharing your faith? (one-on-one evangelism, tracts, etc.)
- 3. Read Acts 2:42-47 aloud. How does this method of church growth (explosion) compare to the church growth methods we tend to utilize today?
- 4. What are some limits we place on our level of devotion in our love for people and love for God? Has there ever been a time when you pushed yourself past your normal standard? What was the result?
- 5. What are some examples of modern day persecution for believers in the Three Village area?
