

"The Death of a Salesman" COLOSSIANS 4:2-6

KEY TERM: EVANGELISM ROOT WORD: GOSPEL

SIMPLE DEFINITION: BRINGING GOOD NEWS

1. Think about your first church experience. Did you feel like an outsider? What were the things about church that made you feel a sense of distance?

THE PROBLEM: Christians are supposed to share their faith, but most don't.

2. Are you comfortable sharing your faith? If not, what makes it uncomfortable?

REASON #1: We don't have good news to share.

3. How have you seen the gospel to be good news in your life? What kinds of personal needs has the good news met?

REASON #2: We don't feel confident sharing it.

- 4. Many of those in the church have been taught that Evangelism is an **event** that all hangs on one conversation. In your own personal experience, have you found your own coming to faith (if you're a Christian) to be a **process** or a one-time **event**?
- 5. Read Colossians 4:2-6 and notice the three step process: Pray, Act, Speak.

Pray: Who are some people in your life who aren't following Jesus that you can pray for, "that good opens a door for your message"?

Act: The Bible refers to Christians as Christ's ambassadors. We represent him. How can this shape the way we understand the importance of the way we live?

Speak: This is an area that many Chrisitans struggle. Rather than focusing on becoming theological experts, learn to speak from experience. Practice this together: How have you see God come through in your own life?
