Acts 28:1-10

Sermon Review:

- Paul is unshakable in uncertainty.
- His faith is what made him unshakable.
- Two suggestions to help your faith grow:
 1. Get to know God better.
 2. Take small steps of faith.

1. Share a time when you were given news of uncertainty. Did this affect other areas of your life? In what kind of ways? How did you respond?
2. Take a minute to talk about the things that Paul has experienced in his effort to get to Rome (especially since chapter 20). How might you have reacted to some of these things? What do you find most impressive about the way Paul has handled these situations?
3. What are some common misconceptions about faith? How does Paul's faith differ from the way many people understand faith today?
4. As our faith grows, we will more naturally respond to uncertainty with faith instead of fear. The more intimately we know God, the stronger our faith will be. What are some ways we can be intentional about getting to know God better?
5. Have you ever experienced a faith "growth spurt"? What was it in that season of life that allowed your faith to grow in such a dramatic way?
6. Paul had seen God come through for him time and time again. In light of this, Lou's final suggestion was to take small steps of faith. Have you ever felt drawn to do something but resisted because of fear? What could be an example of a small step of faith?
7. Is there a difference between faith and foolishness?
8. Finish your time together by praying and thanking God for all he has done in our community.
